

On the genetic affiliation of Vietnamese

Long ago Maspero stated (1912:118) that Vietnamese belonged to the Tai family. Logan (1856) and many others since him have classed Vietnamese within Mon-Khmer or Austroasiatic. Wang Li (1958) observed that Vietnamese is closer to Tai and Mon-Khmer than it is to Chinese. The question is still open.

It is the purpose of this paper to compare some 159 basic vocabulary items from Vietnamese with the clearly Tai languages Thai and Zhuang, and the clearly Austroasiatic languages Wa, Blang, and Palaung, attempting to shed further light on the question of the genetic relationship of Vietnamese.

Though speakers of modern Wa, Blang, and Palaung live hundreds of kilometers from the Vietnamese and have little or no direct communication with them, yet their percentage of apparently related words is far higher than the percentages shown by Thai and Zhuang, geographic neighbors of the Vietnamese.

And furthermore, there are some regular correspondences between Vietnamese and Wa.

(1) The final aspiration *-h* and final glottal *ʔ* in Wa are wholly missing in their Vietnamese cognates. Of the 159 words compared, 33 have final glottal *ʔ* in Wa, of which 12 appear in Vietnamese with *ngang* tone, 10 with *sắc* tone, 7 with *huyền* tone, 3 with *hỏi* tone, 1 with *nặng* tone, and none with *ngã* tone.

Of the 159 words, 16 have final aspiration *-h* in Wa, of which 5 appear in Vietnamese with *ngang* tone, 5 with *sắc* tone, 4 with *hỏi* tone, 1 with *nặng* tone, 1 with *ngã* tone, and none with *huyền* tone.

(2) The aspirated nasal, lateral and trill in Wa are matched by similar unaspirated sounds in Vietnamese.

(3) Some initial nasal consonants in Wa are matched by voiced plosives in Vietnamese.

In addition to the phonetic correspondences shown above, there are also similarities in word cooccurrence patterns and in grammar:

(1) The two languages have similar words for 'child': Vietnamese *con*, Wa *kɔn*. In both languages, when it is joined to another morpheme its meaning changes to 'young, little'.

These phonetic and grammatical similarities would support the hypothesis that Vietnamese is genetically affiliated with the Austroasiatic languages.
